Definitions, restrictions, exclusions. Etc.:

- "Registered" means actually registered for a term, even if later withdrew.
- If registered and canceled (did not attend classes), the student must re-apply to OAR.
- If changing colleges, proceed to the college to which you will be applying.
- Nondegree: go to the college offering the course that you wish to take.
- The student's last enrollment status or class affects whether OAR must get involved in updating information on University records systems for the college office. An application may not be required, but OAR may need to change the student's classification in the records system (e.g., last enrollment was nondegree, even though previously registered degree)

*Freshmen who do not complete their first term in residence must re-apply for admission at OAR.
